# Notes on participation, conduct and management of the hearing

All Interested Parties (IPs) are invited to attend ISH3. The event will also be livestreamed and a link for watching the livestream will be posted on the <u>project page</u> of the National Infrastructure Planning website closer to the event date.

Each IP is entitled to make oral representations at ISH3. However, this is subject to the ExA's power to control the hearing.

The ExA would find it helpful for the following attendees to participate in ISH3:

- Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Limited (the Applicant) including representatives of the Applicant who are in a position to discuss the matters on the agenda
- Denbighshire County Council
- Natural Resources Wales
- Any other Interested Parties with an interest in the proposed substation site and related matters

Participants may be legally represented if they wish, but the hearing will be conducted to ensure that legal representation is not required. Guidance under the Planning Act 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 provide that it is the ExA that will probe, test and assess the evidence through direct questioning of persons making oral representations at hearings. Questioning at the hearing will be led by the ExA.

Every effort will be made to ensure that the issues will be discussed on the day that they are scheduled for. The hearing will finish as soon as the ExA deems that all those present have had their say and that all matters have been covered. If there are additional matters to be dealt with or there are submissions that take a considerable amount of time at any hearing, it may be necessary to prioritise matters and defer others to written questions.

The agenda is for guidance only. It is not designed to be exclusive or exhaustive. The ExA may add other issues for consideration, may alter the order in which issues are considered and will seek to allocate sufficient time to each issue to allow proper consideration of them. Any lack of discussion of a particular issue at a hearing does

not preclude further examination of this issue, including the asking of further written questions.

All Examination documents are provided with a unique identification number for referencing purposes shown in square brackets [].

The evidence presented orally at ISH3 should be included in post-hearing submissions and submitted by **Deadline 3a, Friday 16 December 2022**.

## Purpose of ISH3

The main purpose of ISH3 is to undertake an examination of various environmental matters. In particular, to review environmental impact considerations, including matters arising from the application documentation and representations relating to:

- Good design
- Landscape and visual effects
- Biodiversity, ecology and the natural environment
- Public health and nuisance
- Traffic and transport

### Contingencies

The ExA will endeavour to hear all participants. If the ISH, or parts of it, is unable to proceed, for example for technical reasons, then the ExA may adjourn incomplete business to reserved hearings later in the Examination Timetable.
