Five Estuaries Offshore Windfarm Project Application Ref: EN010115 East Anglia Two Limited Rule 17 Letter issued 16 December 2024

We refer to the Rule 17 letter issued on 13 December at 20:24 requesting that East Anglia Two should provide a wake loss assessment by Deadline 5 (10 January 2025).

We regret our clients would be unable to provide a full wake loss assessment by 10 January 2025. A range of information requires to be collated and there will be technical requirements involved. Given availability of consultants, it likely that limited progress can be made before the week commencing 6 January. It would however be their intention to provide as much interim information as possible at Deadline 5 and seek to ensure that a report with a more detailed wake loss assessment was submitted by Deadline 6 (11 February 2025). We would also wish to alert the ExA to the fact that the Applicant is the best party to provide some of the information required for the model in relation to the proposed project as set out in the annex to this letter. Our clients have discussed this issue with the Applicant and suggested that they provide the information. Our clients consider that this information could be provided to independent consultants with suitable confidential undertakings being provided. In the absence of information being provided by the Applicant then assumptions will have to be made.
