

## Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm Development Consent Order Comments on Submissions Received at Deadline 4 On behalf of London Gateway Port Limited Deadline 5 (10<sup>th</sup> January 2025)

This document provides comment on the Applicant's Outline Cable Specification and Installation Plan (CSIP) – Revision B (Volume 9, Report 12 – Rep4-019 & REP4-020) and is submitted on behalf of London Gateway Port Limited (LGPL – Interested Party – Ref: 20049288).

LGPL's comments relate to the mitigation proposed in Table 1 of the CSIP. Table 1 is recreated below with LGPL proposed amendments set out within the 4<sup>th</sup> Column (added text in red type).

Shipping and Navigation	Reduction in navigable depth	Cables will typically be buried at a target burial depth to be informed by a Cable Burial Risk Assessment (CBRA). A description of the Outline CBRA (Volume 9, Report 9) [APP-239] is provided with the application. Where cable burial is not possible or to sufficient depth, cable protection will be applied, ensuring use of the deep water routes by deep draught vessels is not compromised due to underwater allision risk.  The water depth associated with cable crossings with known projects will be sufficient to allow the installation of the crossing and associated cable protection without reducing navigable depth more than 5%.	The water depth associated with cable crossings with known projects will be sufficient to allow the installation of the crossing and associated cable protection without reducing navigable depth more than 5%, save for within the deepwater routes where navigable depth shall not be reduced
