Whatever Rampion claims, the traffic on A272 and surrounding roads WILL make it very difficult to access doctors, places of employment, hospitals, vets etc.. We in the small lanes are already experiencing tail to tail traffic and grid locking on a regular basis whenever there is a hold up on the A272.
