Sir, I live at and am concerned about the access from the A280 via Long Furlong lane to Black Patch hill ...It is not clear how it is intended to mitigate dis ruption for residents farmers walkers horse riders etc Who use this and the many footpaths and bridleways which will be disrupted by the engineering works.and no doubt ongoing maintenance.

It seems far from clear that there will be a net gain to carbon reduction over the life time of Rampion 2. Clearly a huge cost to the environment will happen together with the manufacturing costs of the turbines themselves. Its hard to see the electricity produced over a 25 year period benefitting carbon reduction.

Whilst accepting we need to address climate change this type of project seems unlikely to produce much other than profit to the construction companys at the expense of the tax payer.
