This letter is provided in response to the Examining Authority's ("ExA") Rule 8 letter - notification of timetable for the examination [PD-008] and is submitted at Deadline 1.

1. SECTION 1 – CO-ORDINATION WITH OTHER PROJECTS

1.1 Co-ordination with other projects

- 1.1.1 As referred to by the Applicant's representative at the Preliminary Meeting, the Co-ordination Report [updated for Deadline 1] [2.5, (Rev 2)] sets out the Applicant's position with respect to co-ordination with other projects and how North Falls, in conjunction with Five Estuaries, has sought to reduce impacts on communities and the local environment.
- 1.1.2 The Applicant has sought to balance the different factors influencing coordination and has taken a systematic approach to exploring the feasibility of different offshore and onshore options, starting from the initial design stage through to the implementation and construction stages.
- 1.1.3 Section 6 of the Co-ordination Report outlines the approach taken with respect to grid connection optionality, the build options, and related delivery scenarios.
- 1.1.4 Section 7 of the Co-ordination Report outlines the approach taken by the project promoters to work collaboratively with one another in practical terms during scheme development; and then details the outcome of this work in terms of the design and siting of both offshore and onshore infrastructure.
- 1.1.5 Section 8 of the Co-ordination Report outlines the enhancement, mitigation, and compensation measures that are shared between NSIPs as well as details the delivery scenarios for how the mitigation measures will be delivered.
- 1.1.6 The Co-ordination Report is a "live" document and will be updated during the course of the Examination where necessary.
- 1.1.7 As set out in paragraphs 5.1.3 of and Appendix B to the Statement of Reasons [AS-028], the Applicant has also adopted a coordinated approach to the negotiation of voluntary agreements with landowners.
