NORTH FALLS OFFSHORE WIND FARM (EN010119) – DEADLINE 7 SUBMISSION

This submission provides an update on all matters that remained outstanding at Deadline 6. National Highways has continued to work with the Applicant and their advisors, and substantial progress has been made.

Junction Modelling and Construction Traffic

The Applicant's transport consultants have undertaken modelling of additional junctions on the A120 due to concerns raised by National Highways and this information has been reviewed in depth by National Highways and our consultants AECOM.

I am pleased to advise that National Highways is now satisfied that the modelling demonstrates that the junctions on the A120 are expected to be able to accommodate safely the additional traffic arising from the construction of the North Falls project.

This matter is therefore resolved, and this is reflected in the latest version of the SOCG to be submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 7.

Protective Provisions

The discussions on National Highways Protective Provisions are almost complete and we envisage being able to confirm that they have been agreed and finalised at Deadline 8.

Whilst this matter continues to be marked as ongoing in the SOCG, National Highways does not foresee any difficulties in closing this matter out before the end of the Examination.
