In considering this documentation, please note the following:

- 4. The Application Document Tracker and Application Guide have been updated to reflect the latest status and list of documents submitted as part of the Examination process.
- 5. The draft DCO has been updated at Deadline 9 (Rev 11) to reflect changes arising from ongoing discussions with stakeholders and points covered by the response to the Rule 17 letter dated 22 June 2023.
- 6. The Explanatory Memorandum has been updated to reflect changes to the draft DCO since Deadline 4.
- 7. The Statement of Reasons has been updated in response to a request included in the Rule 17 letter dated 22 June 2023, to reflect that the Applicant seeks seven years in which to commence construction of the Proposed Scheme and exercise compulsory acquisition powers.
- 8. The Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought document has been updated to set out the engagement that the Applicant has undertaken since Deadline 8. The progress as at 06/07/23 is summarised in the table below:

- 9. The Applicant has also updated the Register of Environmental Actions and Commitments at Deadline 9, to include a minor change to item PH3, in response to ongoing discussions with the Consortium of landowners and EOF Ltd. Details of the discussions are set out in the Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought referred to above.
- 10. The Applicant continues to engage with all Statement of Common Ground parties, and intends to submit the following updated SoCGs at Deadline 10:
 - Statement of Common Ground between National Grid ESO and Drax Power Limited
 - Statement of Common Ground between National Grid Carbon Limited and Drax Power Limited
 - Statement of Common Ground between The North Yorkshire Council and Drax Power Limited (Rev 07)
 - Statement of Common Ground between National Highways and Drax Power Limited
 - Statement of Common Ground between East Riding of Yorkshire Council and Drax Power Limited
 - Statement of Common Ground between National Grid Electricity Transmission and Drax Power Limited

- 11. The Statement of Commonality has been updated at Deadline 9 to reflect updates to SoCGs and the position more generally at this time.
- 12. The Applicant submitted Air Quality Technical Note 3 (hereafter referred to as 'AQ TN3') into the Examination at Deadline 8. AQ TN3 was produced in response to a series of changes to the data held on the Air Pollution Information System (APIS). These changes took place in late May 2023, and varied a range of data relevant to the assessment of air quality impacts on ecological features, relative to the APIS data used in 2022 to inform the ES and subsequent assessment work. AQ TN3 provided a summary of how these changes were potentially relevant to the Proposed Scheme and the European Sites and SSSI. Due to the short amount of time available between identifying the changes to APIS and Deadline 8, the Applicant was not able to review the changes with Natural England (NE). The Applicant has subsequently discussed the APIS updates with NE and requested their advice as to whether the APIS updates should be incorporated into the Air Quality and Ecology Assessments. NE have advised that, given the advanced stage of the Examination, the APIS updates should not be incorporated into the assessment. NE have stated that, 'We are satisfied with the assessment and the approach taken based on the best available information at the time that the assessment was undertaken'.
- 13. Based on the advice received from NE, the Applicant therefore requests that the ExA considers AQ TN3 to be withdrawn. The Applicant is not intending to reflect the May 2023 APIS updates in any subsequent Examination documents.
- 14. Given that AQ TN3 is to be withdrawn, there are only minor changes included in the D9 version of the Habitats Regulations Assessment, relating to:
 - The Applicant's responses to the ExA's Rule 17 Questions of 6 June 2023;
 - Updates to baseline concentrations of NOx in air over the Humber Estuary SAC,
 SPA, and Ramsar to correct a previously reported error; and
 - The latest SoCG between Natural England and Drax Power Limited (REP8-019).
- 15. The Environmental Statement Appendix 6.5 has been updated to reflect maximum NOx concentrations over the Humber Estuary designated sites in the 2017-2019 APIS data that has been used by the Applicant to date. In addition, typographical errors were identified in Table 1.14 of the Appendix, where annual mean impacts were included within a table of daily mean impacts and these have been corrected in the latest Appendix.
- 16. The Applicant's responses to submissions received at Deadline 8 is provided within document 8.10.8.
- 17. The ExA published its Report on the Implications for European Sites (RIES) on 14 June 2023 and the Applicant has prepared responses to the applicable questions within Document 8.21.
- 18. There was one Relevant Representation received in response to the Second Change Application from Northern Gas Networks. The Applicant's response to this representation was provided in the Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought dated 13 June 2023 (REP8-008) and a further update is now provided in Document 8.22 in response to the ExA's Question R17QC.1.

- 19. The Applicant's responses to Rule 17 Questions from Letters dated 22 and 29 June 2023 (R17QB and R17QC) are provided within Document 8.22.
- 20. Enclosed with this letter are the above documents via the file upload facility on the project application website¹, as agreed with the Inspectorate via the Rule 6 letter on 13 December 2022.
