1DCO8	Micrositing a) Within condition 9(1)(a)(ii) should there be a maximum limit for micrositing within the two lines of orientation? If so, what should this be? b) Should this be allowed to be varied by consent, and if so, who should grant this consent, and should there be any limits on variation?	 a) MCA requests there is a maximum limit of 55m stated for micro-siting within the condition. This is consistent with the relevant conditions in the Mona and Morgan DCOs. We proposed the condition is amended to: "and offshore substation platform subject to up to 55m micro-siting in any direction unless otherwise agreed in writing with the MMO in consultation with the MCA and Trinity House." b) As per the above, any variation must be discussed with MCA and Trinity House before agreement by the MMO.
