On 4, 5 and 6 February 2025 we held Issue Specific Hearings into the above project.

At Deadline 3, Wednesday 22 January 2025, the Applicant submitted a document entitled 'Habitats Regulations Assessment Without Prejudice Derogation Case – Red-Throated Diver at Liverpool Bay / Bar Lerpwl SPA'. This can be found in the Examination Library at reference [REP3-065].

This provides, on a without prejudice basis, for compensation for the effects of the Proposed Development on Red Throated Diver were the Secretary of State to conclude that, there being no alternative solutions, the plan or project must be carried out for imperative reasons of overriding public interest.

As you will note, the compensation sites concerned are located in Scotland and consequently NatureScot is requested make any comments it feels appropriate.
