The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended) – Rule 8(3)

Application by Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Ltd for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Generation Assets

Change to Examination Timetable (including the cancellation of the hearings scheduled for the week commencing 31 March 2025)

I write further to our Rule 8 letter of 30 October 2024 (Examination Library reference: [PD-010]) where we set out the timetable for the examination of the above project.

This included information about hearings and the submission of information at deadlines.

As part of our continuing management of the case and its timetable, and in particular as a number of statutory advisors have been unable to attend hearings, we have reviewed the timetable to the end of the examination.

We have concluded that having hearings in the week commencing 31 March 2025 would be disproportionate to the issues remaining, but that we will require additional information, principally to deal with those points that we would have raised in the hearings.

We therefore intend to issue a further set of written questions on Tuesday 25 March 2025 (ExQ3).

The questions will be published at the same time as our publication of the Report on the Implications for European Sites (RIES) and any associated questions and our commentary on, or schedule of changes to, the draft DCO.

In order to ensure fairness, that is to allow the responses to ExQ3 to be received, considered and where necessary responded to, we consider that there should be an

additional deadline before the end of the examination, **deadline 5A**, **Tuesday 8 April 2025** for responses to ExQ3.

In providing this additional deadline, we would encourage parties, where possible, to submit any documents at that deadline that would otherwise have needed to wait until deadline 6 (15 April 2025). In this we are particularly thinking of signed Statements of Common Ground, or Natural England's comments on the appropriate calculations for the compensation quanta which it has indicated would be provided at D6. These, hopefully, would allow matters to be resolved more expeditiously and within the overall examination timetable.

This letter is therefore to advise interested parties that we have made a procedural decision to amend the examination timetable to this effect. This is:

- (a) to cancel the hearings scheduled for the week commencing 31 March 2025;
- (b) to indicate that the ExA will publish its additional written questions (ExQ3) on 25 March 2025;
- (c) for parties to respond to these additional written questions (ExQ3) by a new deadline, 5A, on Tuesday 8 April 2025; and
- (d) for the opportunity then to respond to those submissions at the existing deadline 6 on 15 April 2025.

Appendix A to this letter sets out the revised timetable.

Can I thank parties for their co-operation in meeting these deadlines.

The Secretary of State may rely on the consultation on the RIES to meet its obligations under Regulation 63(3) of The Habitats Regulations 2017 and/ or Regulation 28 of The Offshore Marine Regulation.
