Morecambe Offshore Wind Farm Reference EN010121

We refer to the application submitted by the Developer under the relevant legislation ("Application") to The Planning Authority.

NERL has objected to the Application as its assessment is that the proposed development will cause an adverse impact to primary radar and associated air traffic operations of NERL located at Lowther Hill, St Annes and Great Dun Fell without suitable mitigation.

An agreement has been entered into between NERL and the Developer on or around the date of this letter which identifies suitable, agreed Requirements and further to which the identification and development of a mitigation solution in relation to the development will take place.

NERL therefore withdraws its objection to the Application subject to the imposition of the agreed requirement 4 (Great Dun Fell, Lowther Hill and St Annes Primary Surveillance Radars) included in the version of the Draft Development Consent Order submitted at Deadline 6 (REP6-002).
