Dear Secretary of State

We act for BHP Billiton Petroleum Great Britain Limited (BHP), who have received the letter dated 6 March 2026 requesting an update with respect the crossing and proximity agreements required for the interface between assets held by BHP which overlap with the Order limits for the Dogger Bank South Offshore Wind Farms project.

The parties have been engaged in an agreement to confirm that the required crossing and proximity agreement will be entered into in due course ahead of any works taking place within 500m of BHP's apparatus. This agreement has recently been signed by both parties but has not yet been completed.

Ahead of the side agreement being entered into, BHP must reserve its representation in respect of the Dogger Bank South Offshore Wind Farms project. BHP hopes that agreement will complete shortly and will update the Secretary of State once this position is confirmed.

Once complete, BHP understands that the Applicant will progress with the required crossing and proximity agreement, based on the terms of the side agreement.
