## EN010128: APPLICATION BY CORY ENVIRONMENTAL HOLDINGS LIMITED FOR AN ORDER GRANTING DEVELOPMENT CONSENT FOR THE CORY DECARBONISATION PROJECT – EXAMINATION TIMETABLE DEADLINE 5

I write on behalf of the Applicant, Cory Environmental Holdings Limited, to provide its Deadline 5 submissions in respect of the Examination for the Cory Decarbonisation Project.

The Applicant can confirm that there have been no policy announcements at this stage which require updates to the Policy Accordance Tracker, save that, as set out in some of the responses to the Examining Authority's questions, the Applicant can confirm that the project is consistent with the recently published Seventh Carbon Budget, published on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2025 which sets legally binding limits on the UK's greenhouse gas emissions for 2028 - 2042 to support Net Zero targets.

The Applicant notes also that it has, in its Deadline 5 submissions and following extensive discussions with stakeholders, reached the position that only the following substantive planning matters, that are considered resolvable within the remaining Examination, remain to be dealt with:

- resolving the final navigational matters with the PLA in order to get to a final version of the pNRA and SoCG with the PLA;
- MMO concerns in relation to dredging arisings disposal and the DML in order to get to a final version of the SoCG with the MMO;
- the EA's protective provisions;
- Natural England's comments in respect of cumulative assessment and the Thames Inner Marshes SSSI;
- DCO drafting in respect of WRWA's interests; and
- agreeing the final form of the Deeds of Obligations with TWUL, Peabody and LBB (and associated SoCGs).

The Applicant is working hard with stakeholders to resolve these matters as soon as possible and confirms that it will update the ExA as soon as matters have progressed on them, rather than waiting for Deadline 6.

I would be grateful if you could confirm receipt of this letter and the accompanying documents.
