Dudgeon Offshore Wind Limited

GT R4 Limited, trading as Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind ("the Applicant"), is proposing to develop the Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind project ("the Project"). This representation is being made by Dudgeon Offshore Wind Limited (DOWL) regarding the application for development consent for the Project ("the Application"). DOWL is the owner of the Dudgeon Offshore Wind Farm, which is located approximately 32 km from the North Norfolk Coast in the Southern North Sea and has been operating since 2017. DOWL is the holder of a generation licence under the Electricity Act 1989.

It is the view of DOWL that it should be considered a relevant statutory undertaker in accordance with Regulation 3 and Schedule 1 of the Infrastructure Planning (Interested Parties and Miscellaneous Prescribed Provisions) Regulations 2015 and DOWL therefore kindly requests to be treated as an Interested Party for the remainder of the Examination and during the Secretary of State determination period.

DOWL notes the Wake Loss Technical Note (REP4-114) submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 4 and in particular the predicted impacts on the Dudgeon Offshore Wind Farm in Table 4-1. DOWL wishes to register its interest due to concerns over the potential implications of wake loss on its continued operations and reserves the right to make further, more detailed, representations in relation to these impacts.
