

**Scira Offshore Energy Limited**

GT R4 Limited, trading as Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind ("the Applicant"), is proposing to develop the Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind project ("the Project"). This representation is being made by Scira Offshore Energy Limited (SOEL) regarding the application for development consent for the Project ("the Application"). SOEL is the owner of the Sheringham Shoal Offshore Wind Farm, which is located approximately 20 km from the North Norfolk Coast in the Southern North Sea and has been operating since 2012. SOEL is the holder of a generation licence under the Electricity Act 1989.

It is the view of SOEL that it should be considered a relevant statutory undertaker in accordance with Regulation 3 and Schedule 1 of the Infrastructure Planning (Interested Parties and Miscellaneous Prescribed Provisions) Regulations 2015 and SOEL therefore kindly requests to be treated as an Interested Party for the remainder of the Examination and during the Secretary of State determination period.

SOEL notes the Wake Loss Technical Note (REP4-114) submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 4 and in particular the predicted impacts on the Sheringham Shoal Offshore Wind Farm in Table 4-1. SOEL wishes to register its interest due to concerns over the potential implications of wake loss on its continued operations and reserves the right to make further, more detailed, representations in relation to these impacts.
