
This letter provides an update on matters relevant to the determination of the Morgan Generation Assets DCO application. The update coincides with the end of the Examining Authority's (ExA's) recommendation period. The Applicant requests that it is provided to the Secretary of State alongside the ExA's recommendation report.

The Applicant has provided an update on matters that were outstanding at the end of the Morgan Generation Assets examination, and which have now been resolved. In addition to the matter below, the Applicant is continuing to engage with relevant Interested Parties on other matters that were outstanding or unresolved at the end of the Morgan Generation Assets examination and would be happy to provide an update on those matters to the Secretary of State on request.

Update on Shipping Commercial Agreements

The Applicant has been engaging with Stena Line since the close of the examination. The Applicant is pleased to report that the Ferry Mitigation Agreement between Stena Line Limited and Morgan Offshore Wind Limited was signed on 23 May 2025. As part of this agreement, Stena Line submitted a letter to the SoS within 10 days from signing, withdrawing their objection to the Development Consent Order (DCO) application.
