**REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

1. Following the completion of the Examination on 16 January 2025, the Examining Authority (“ExA”) submitted its Report and Recommendation in respect of its findings and conclusions on the above application to the Secretary of State on 16 April 2025. In accordance with section 107 of the Planning Act 2008 (“PA 2008”), the Secretary of State has three months to determine the application.
2. The Secretary of State requests that the **Applicant, Isle of Man Steam Packet Company, and Gwynt y Môr OFTO Plc** provide updates as set out below.

**Commercial negotiations and agreements**

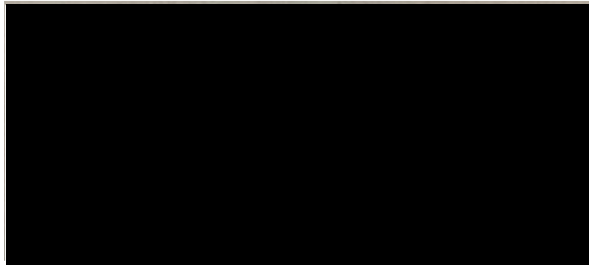
3. The **Applicant and Isle of Man Steam Packet Company** should provide an update on the status of their Ferry Mitigation Agreement negotiations. If agreement has not been reached, updates should include details of whether an agreement is expected, and if so when agreement is expected.
4. The **Applicant and Gwynt y Môr OFTO Plc** should provide an update on the status of their negotiations. If agreement has not been reached, updates should include details of whether an agreement is expected, and if so when agreement is expected.
