Subject: Response to request for information: update on status of negotiations between GyM

OFTO and the Applicant

Following our previous correspondence by letter on 14 January 2025 and 14 April 2025, Osborne Clarke LLP continue to act on behalf of GyM OFTO.

GyM OFTO is a statutory undertaker with an offshore transmission owner's licence. GyM OFTO owns and operates the transmission infrastructure for the Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm. The wind farm comprises 160 wind turbine generators connected onshore by four c.20km subsea export cables, with onshore cables of c.11km long connecting to the 400kV onshore substation at Bodelwyddan, near St. Asaph (the "**Bodelwyddan National Grid Substation**").

The Order land runs through land that forms part of the Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm. As such we (on behalf of GyM OFTO) and the Applicant's representatives have been liaising to agree a suitable form of protective provisions along with a supplemental commercial side agreement (the "Agreements").

Following the receipt of the Secretary of State's letter dated 5 June 2025 requesting further information on the status of these negotiations, we are pleased to inform that the Agreements are in engrossed form and approved by both GyM OFTO and the Applicant. We will be able to remove GyM OFTO's holding representation once the Agreements have completed, which we expect to happen shortly.
