Mona Offshore Wind Generation Project application for development consent - received by the Planning Inspectorate on 22 February 2024 - PINS reference: EN010137 ("Mona DCO")

Commercial agreement between: (1) MONA OFFSHORE WIND LIMITED (registered number 13497266) ("Mona"); and (2) Stena Line Limited (registered number 01402237)

We write on behalf of Stena Line Limited ("Stena") in respect of the above application for a development consent application for the Mona DCO.

Following extensive discussions, the Applicant and Stena have entered into a commercial agreement which seeks to address the impacts to Stena's ferry routes which will arise as a result of the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of the Mona Offshore Wind Generation Project.

As a consequence, we are now instructed to write formally on behalf of Stena to confirm that it withdraws its objection to the Mona DCO application as from the date of this letter.

For the avoidance of any doubt, we can also confirm on behalf of our client that its request for Protective Provisions for the benefit of Stena to be included in the DCO – in the form of the draft Protective Provisions appended to Stena's representations submitted at Deadline 7 [REP7-155] and discussed at paragraphs 2.4.22 – 2.4.25 of that representation - is also now withdrawn.
