Re: Withdrawal of Representation to the Mona Offshore Wind Farm Order


We are instructed by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("Network Rail") in relation to the Mona Offshore Wind Farm Order ("the Order").

The application for the Order was submitted by Mona Offshore Wind Farm Limited ("the Promoter") and accepted by the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero for examination on 21 March 2024.

We write further to Network Rail's Relevant Representation of 3 May 2024 which set out Network Rail's grounds of objection to the Order.

Network Rail has now entered into a Framework Agreement with the Promoter (completed 29.01.2025) which appends Network Rail's Protective Provisions, addressing Network Rail's concerns. Accordingly, we write to confirm that Network Rail's representation is hereby withdrawn.
