High Court proceedings

There is no right of appeal under PA2008. The High Court may entertain proceedings to question an order granting development consent from the day on which the Development Consent Order is published or, if later, the day on which the decision letter is published. The procedure is to make an application for judicial review. This must be done within the statutory period of time set out in s118 of PA2008.
