Natural England has provided advice on the outcomes of the functionally linked land assessment and have determined that the development site supports a significant number of lapwings. The Applicant has proposed mitigation for this loss of habitat which we have agreed to in principle.	The proposed mitigation measures should be included within an updated oLEMP to ensure they are secured within the DCO. Natural England will review this document when the revisions have been completed. This information will also be submitted within an updated HRA.	Likely to be addressed during Examination. Natural England have reviewed and agree with the proposals in principle.

PADS2	NE1, NE2, NE11 and NE12	Noise disturbance to birds using FLL associated with the Humber Estuary SPA / Ramsar / SSSI and Lower Derwent Valley SPA / Ramsar (and underpinning SSSIs, Derwent Ings, Melbourne & Thornton Ings, and Breighton Meadows) (Construction)	Natural England have reviewed additional submitted information through our DAS and have determined that noise impacts to land adjacent to the development proposals have been suitably addressed in the latest draft HRA. We will provide additional comments on this topic in a SoCG with the Applicant. However following the proposals for lapwing mitigation, we advise there should be consideration of potential disturbance to the mitigation area during construction.	Inclusion of information on the potential for noise impacts to the mitigation area, with suitable mitigation if required. (Construction and Operation)	The previous iteration of the draft HRA did not include a full in combination assessment of the impacts.
