We fully appreciate that the examination stage of the Helios project has now closed and no further submissions to the Examiner are possible.

However, an amendment made by Enso, that was submitted on the 27 May 2025, has only just come to our attention, which both alarms and disturbs us in equal measure!

I attach the relevant pages, apparently 'buried' within the Draft Development Consent Order - Schedule of Changes.

It appears that, should approval be granted, Enso are able to operate during the construction phase for 24 hours per day, without respite nor consideration of the resultant noise levels.

We ask how can this possibly be acceptable or permissible?

It is surely against all environmental and health and safety guidelines and is yet more evidence of the apparent total disregard to the residents of our relatively small community.


