I am a long time resident of Camblesforth and i am compelled to object to the introduction of additional solar farms. I am seriously worried that we are about to be surrounded by Solar panels, battery storage and maintenance facilities.

Our gentle way of life will be forever spoiled by the constant flow of construction vehicles along village roads, the intrusive and constant noise of up to 100 battery and storage systems. These storage systems will produce between 70-90 db of noise meaning a constant high pitched buzz will be heard throughout the village, day and night for approximately 40 years. This will obviously have a negative impact on the mental health and well being of the local residents.

The toxic gases produced by these storage facilities which will include Lithium hexa-fluoro-phosphate / hydrogen fluoride / phosphoryl fluoride plus combustible gasses hydrogen / methane / ethylene / carbon monoxide & propylene. These are obviously detrimental to the health and well-being of the local community.

One example of how things can go dangerously wrong being in 2020 a 20 MWh BESS in Liverpool took over 11 hours to contain and resulted in an explosion and release of toxic gasses.
