

I would respectfully ask that the lead inspector Mr. G. Sword includes an inspection of the proposed temporary road where it is supposed to join the B660 Kimbolton to Bedford road noting in particular where it crosses the road to join the unmade gravel road to site A. Traffic will have to turn right onto the B660 and then left onto the current farm road. This will be a dangerous manoeuvre on a stretch of road which sees the speed limit increase from 40 mph to 60 mph. Furthermore the unmade gravel, single track will be noisy, dusty, and totally inappropriate for such a volume of HGV's. Also note the proximity to homes. During the previous, much smaller build for the existing Manor Farm solar this became a real problem with traffic queuing to get onto the track. Please see photos showing both the entrance from the B660 and how close HGVs will be to my property as well as damage caused to the highway.
