

Having reviewed the proposed ASI I do not feel it gives enough coverage to the West End of the Proposed development. The POL L is a walk along a limited amount of the footpath and bridleway but in order to fully understand the impact on the village of Keysoe and the much larger surrounding area the examiner needs to progress at least a further 300m west along the ridgeway ( its a clear track ) where the proposal is to have panels set back and up to 3 meters high. These will be seen from miles in many directions, and will have a direct impact on the local area, particularly those living on Mill Hill and Church Road in Keysoe.

The proposed panels will also create a new ridgeline, as the change to move them back 50 m from the original scheme has no effect, due to the top of the ridge being flat.

I was of the opinion that in planning policy development should not have a significant impact on site lines and landscape features and this will !!

I hope you will ensure that you fully examine the west end of this proposal and conclude that it is not an appropriate site.
