

Dear Sirs , I write on behalf of Bolnhurst and Keysoe Parish Council having reviewed the Applicants Proposed Itinerary for the Accompanied Site Inspection and following the feedback submitted by Councillor Faulkner on behalf of the Parish Council on 7th April ref [REDACTED]

We note that POL L The Walk along the Footpath 26 and Bridleway 37 stop at the edge of the spinney and does not extend along the ridgeway to where the panels are due to be located. In order to understand the impact on Keysoe and the visibility of the panels for the surrounding countryside please can you extend the walk a further 200m west along the ridgeway where you will fully appreciate the views and the distance from which the panels will be seen as well as the direct visibility for the residents of Mill Hill and Church Road in Keysoe (Brook End)

With the proposed panels being up to 3 metres high this will also enable you to understand how they will effectively change the ridgeline as the Western end of the proposed development – a major impact on the rural countryside so loved by our parishioners.
