

My objection is based on the principle that large scale solar developments should not be sited on agricultural land. The UK's food security, rural economy, and farming sustainability are protected under the NPPF, the Agriculture Act 2020, and DEFRA's Food Security Report. Removing farmland for 30–40 years undermines these obligations. Renewable energy is important, but it must be delivered through rooftop solar, brownfield sites, and other non-agricultural land, not at the expense of national food production.
