

I wish to raise serious concerns as to the conduct of the examination process and the way in which the timetable is being compressed. Delays in publishing materials means that there is insufficient time to respond to vital points. This is absolutely denying residents and other concerned individuals and groups the opportunity to make their case against the developer.

It is obvious that the examination process is being rushed through with unseemly haste. Vital issues are being given the most superficial coverage and too many issues are being deferred until after approval!! Areas of concern such as the BESS/live Gas line, National Highways concerns and the lack of a grid connection remain unresolved. Even site visits have been downgraded to drone footage which is absolutely NOT a reasonable substitute for personal viewing.

Those of us whose homes and surroundings are threatened by this scheme are being denied the opportunity to present a full and considered challenge to this scheme which will destroy the Bedfordshire countryside and its agricultural contribution to the nation's food security

The British public rely on the Inspectorate to carry out a fair and balanced examination of NSIP proposals, giving an equal hearing to the views on all sides. This is not happening in this instance.
