

Supplementary Comments on the Digital Survey Material

These supplementary comments are submitted following my review of the additional Digital Site Survey material published on 3rd August after my previous representation. They are intended to supplement, rather than replace, my earlier submissions.

Following publication of the additional videos, I made every effort to review the material. In doing so, I encountered further accessibility difficulties. When accessed via my iPhone, the videos displayed a crossed-out play symbol and would not play, despite appearing to have downloaded successfully. I was only able to view them using a desktop computer.

Having viewed the videos, I remain concerned that their evidential value is limited. The recordings are short, moving sequences captured using a wide-angle (fisheye) lens. They do not provide the stationary panoramic views or opportunity to examine key features in any detail. As a result, they are of limited assistance in understanding the landscape, topography, public rights of way, visual receptors and other site-specific features that the Examining Authority sought to consider through the Virtual Site Inspection.

These difficulties reinforce the concerns I have previously raised regarding the late publication of examination material, the limited time available for Interested Parties to review it, and the resulting restriction on meaningful scrutiny before the close of the Examination.

I respectfully request that these supplementary comments be placed on the Examination record.
