7000 Acres Submission relating to the Assessment of Human Health and Wellbeing Impacts associated with the Tillbridge Solar Project

Requesting answers to questions 7000 Acres have raised in their Written Representation REP2-032

This is a further document to support the submission **7000 Acres Additional Information for the Examination Authority on Health, Safety and Wellbeing.**

7000 Acres have not seen the answers to the questions asked in our written representation REP2-032 (7000 Acres response to the Equality Impact Assessment (EqIA), Human Health and Wellbeing and Noise (Operational) - submission date 14th November 2024).

7000 Acres believes this is a serious omission on the part of the applicant.

Furthermore, the applicant's experts were not available for ISH3 when the topic of health was on the agenda, so we do not believe this important topic has been given enough attention.

7000 Acres requested a special hearing on this topic, which we gather is now not feasible, so again, along with the other three solar NSIP's in the West Lindsey District, we are not able to take part in a hearing examining the Applicant's submissions and evidence on this important topic. This would have provided an opportunity to have local and regional experts on health in the room to assist the Examining Authority.

Therefore, 7000 Acres requests the Applicant's experts answer our questions submitted in the written representation REP2-032 and if possible, to provide further evidence that they clearly understand the issues around this topic and so provide such evidence for the Examining Authority to inform any subsequent recommendation to the Secretary of State.
