

Aircraft taking off from the airport will immediately pass over the fields adjacent to Begbroke where a vast array of solar panels will be installed all carefully aligned to bounce the take-off noise into the village. Studies have shown this will treble the take-off noise projected into the village!

Previously we were accustomed to the noise of 73000 light training and small business jet aircraft movements per annum but Cherwell Council allowed the airport to change from light aircraft to 50 passenger airliners which have already produced a vast increase in the take-off noise permeating the village. Adding solar panels directly under this low level flight path is therefore totally unacceptable and a panel exclusion zone should be added to the scheme to reduce the noise in Begbroke.
