1 Heritage Asset Concordance Tables

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 These heritage asset concordance tables have been prepared in response to Question Q1.6.5 in the Examining Authority's First Written Questions and Request for Information [**PD-008**]. This was a request directed at the Applicant to provide a table that showed the 'scoped-in' heritage assets with the information arranged under site areas and field numbers.
- 1.1.2 Two separate tables have been prepared in response to this request. Table 1.1 shows those heritage assets that were 'scoped-in' for detailed assessment (of impacts ands effects) as set out in ES Appendix 7.5: Settings Assessment (Rev 1) [REP2-014]. The table provides the asset name, also the National Heritage List for England (NHLE) number (as appropriate), the Botley West heritage gazetteer reference number (as appropriate, prefixed BW) and information regarding the asset type scheduled monument, listed building etc.
- 1.1.3 Table 1.2 provides information regarding the known or potential buried archaeological remains on a field-by-field basis. The information includes the field number (as indicated on Figure 2 in ES Appendix 7.1: Historic Environment Desk-based Assessment [APP-131], the Botley West heritage gazetteer reference number (pre-fixed BW), information gained from the review of aerial photographs (ES Appendix 7.2: Assessment of Airborne Remote Sensing and Satellite Imagery for Archaeology [APP-132]) and information gained from the geophysical survey (ES Appendix 7.3: Geophysical Survey Report [APP-133 APP-140]). An additional column has been provided for the inclusion of information gained from the programme of archaeological trial trenching this will be included within a revised version of this document once the results of the programme of trial trenching are available.
