To whom it may concern:

I would like to make the following closing statement in relation to The proposed application for a solar farm at Botley West Oxfordshire.

PVDP's attitude makes a mockery of the whole process as it has failed to respond and/or ignored examiners' legitimate questions and requirements. An application cannot be allowed to succeed when it has not even met the most basic requirements of the process by which the decision will be made.

Further, and more specifically I am concerned by the lack of evidence that the applicants are not taking productive land out of food production.
