Please find below my response to the proposed solar farm.

- 1) Proximity of solar panels to houses. I support a minimum distance of 250 metres between the edge of any part of the proposed solar array and any residential dwelling.
- 2) Fencing and other enclosure methods. These should be subject to a design review process, instead of just opting for a lowest cost solution, carried out by independent experts, to the satisfaction of local planning authorities.
- 3) Width of Public Rights of Way. To avoid the impression of narrow corridors through the panels' fencing there should be a minimum of 15 metres width for public rights of way and be clearly identified as PRowS.
- 4) In view of the known short, medium and long term effects of climate change, it should be agreed by all parties concerned that contingency plans must be undertaken and published to accommodate flooding generally and emergency landing requirements for the airport at Kidlington.
