I am writing again to lodge my objections to the above proposal, the various reasons for which are eruditely detailed in the submissions by Stop Botley West.

The recent attempt by PVDP to hurriedly carry out the RVAA shows many errors and omissions and cannot be seen as a substantive or fair basis on which to make the huge decision of whether or not the proposal is approved.

The inspectorate's recommendation that any solar installation shall not be nearer to any residential property boundary than 250m is warmly welcomed.

Solar energy is an excellent idea on roofs but not when it armour plates huge swathes of countryside. At the first consultation I attended, I was told by a PVDP representative that "you won't see them" when referring to the panels which was shocking on two levels: firstly, that is was completely untrue and, secondly, that the speaker still expected to be believed.
