I am a resident of Begbroke and 3 of my 5 boys were born here. We have invested highly in the local area and we are guardians of and own Begbroke Wood.

We are all very concerned and disturbed that the fields around us are planned to have a huge amount of solar panels.

From an artists perspective, this area has a huge significance, having seen landscapes by artists such as Turner, John Piper and Paul Nash, all of whom recorded and documented this area.

The area has unique and unspoilt views across the fields to Oxford. All this is now under severe pressure from a deal done and passed by the university and the council under the guise of "unmet housing needs".

The fields around were vital for mental health during the lockdown and pandemic time
And have continued to be so since .

We are alarmed by the idea of Solar panels in all the fields nearby and urge the council to reconsider.
