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Dear Sirs,

I wish to maintain my objection to this proposal. The responses from the applicant have not addressed critical issues and continue to be biased and erroneous. Much critical information has not been produced.

The proposed solar estate would be seriously harmful to the amenity of the local population; much of the area is valuable Green Belt, very well used for recreation, as is the open countryside. It would adversely impact on the setting of the Blenheim World Heritage Site and the many heritage assets in the area. There has been inadequate assessment of impacts, which have been underplayed.

There is no credible evidence that this proposal could be properly implemented. A partial implementation, thereby taking up the consent, could result in a compromised degraded landscape.

I wholeheartedly object to this proposal and consider the local councils should actively research appropriate strategies for renewable energy
