OBJECTIONS.

- 1) If PVDP cannot apply for planning permission on time, or answer essential questions about plans for the site, how can they be trusted to build this very large and complex project?
- 2) The Sub-station (an exceptionally ugly building) has not passed through the planning process.
- 3) The so-called 'Buffer Zone' has not been agreed. Residents in the effected areas have not been consulted
- 4) Damage, or destruction, to trees, hedges and wild-life
- 5) Airport safety - Glare.

Above and beyond these points Botley West Solar Power Station is unsuited to this agricultural area with its small stone-built villages.
It is a bad scheme and should be rejected.
