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I am very concerned about the proposal for the solar panels on the fields around my home on 2 sides of [REDACTED] In fact very worried for the following reasons:

1. Visual impact - it would destroy my view which I have had for 60 years.
2. Security - as I only have a 3ft-4ft fence round my garden, the proposed deer fence they will put around this will look like a prison to me!! I have not had an RVAA visual inspection and insist that one should be carried out.
3. The Buffer zone - must be at least 250 meters from my boundary, and I want proof of that in writing before they start please.

The whole process has been very unprofessional and incompetently handled.

This must not go ahead so close to this delightful village with good agricultural land. It is criminal when I read in the paper this week that we have too much power and no way to store it.
