Dear Sir or Madam

I am writing to add my objection to PVDP's proposal of another large submission to the Secretary of State re the above after the approved time for doing so has passed.

In your refusal letter, when they previously asked for an extension, it was made clear that this was not acceptable on many fronts including fairness, democracy, credibility, transparency and legality.

PVDP have had ample time and funds to carry out appropriate research and provide responses within the time frame but have chosen not to do so. Indeed, they have still not visited our property as part of an RVAA despite it having been put forward to them.

All other interested parties have complied with timeframes for submission and responses and it is not acceptable that they should be allowed more time having had every opportunity to make their case in the past.

It is possible that they now realise that the many and various substantive objections to their proposal are such that it merits refusal. More time should not be allowed for them to latterly scabble around to bulk out this ill conceived proposal for financial gain.
