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Dear Secretary of State

I'm led to believe that the Applicant in this case is now intending to send in significant new submissions even though, as confirmed by you, the formal Examination deadline passed some considerable time ago.

I must object to this on the basis that this shows a total disregard for the statutory framework within which all other parties have been working and which you duly reminded the Applicant of in your letter of June 8th.

It also brings to the fore, yet again, the opinion held by the Planning Inspector in his letter to the Applicant of October 14th, 2025 (Point 10) that the Applicant comes across "*as being very dismissive of anyone's view but your own*".

Such further submissions by the Applicant simply removes the opportunity for other parties to respond and, as such, makes a nonsense of the legal, democratic process.

I would therefore respectfully ask that the Secretary of State should not accept submissions of any new material from the Applicant.
