You don't often get email from [REDACTED]

I wish to draw your attention to the intention of the Solar Farm group, the Botley project, and their intention to release a large amount of new information into the planning process on or around the 16th July 2026.

As you know, PVDP requested an extension (of 3+ months to Sept 25th) of their 9 June deadline to answer the Secretary of State's many questions and this request was refused by the SoS. This means that they should not submit any new material after 9th June.

However, the Applicant is now openly talking about their intention to make some substantial **new submissions** around 16 July with newly updated Masterplans and updated assessments including Residential Visual Amenity despite their deadline to do this having passed.

This must NOT be allowed to happen. The process is quite clear and it does not allow for these late submissions.

I trust that you will ensure that the correct process is followed and this new material is NOT accepted by your good offices.
