Dear Sir,

I am writing to protest at the possible preferential treatment being afforded to PVDP regarding this proposed Solar panel development.

The deadline for submissions has past (9th June) but I understand PVDP is trying to circumvent the Planning process by submitting some new documents later this week. They have had ample time to get their ducks in a row and this seems to be a delaying tactic. They have known what the process entails for many months (or years) but still they think they re entitled to 'extra time'. - other interested parties have submitted their comments in a timely manner, why not PVDP ?

The Secretary of State has already indicated that "an extension.... could create an undesirable precedent....undermining confidence in the planning process..."

I am concerned that if this late submission were to be allowed, I would not have time to respond as this is part of my democratic rights.

Finally, I would urge the Secretary of State not to accept any submissions of new material from PVDP which I understand they are hoping to do on 16th July 2026
