Dear BotleyWestSolar

There are many areas where the applicant's assessments are insufficiently presented. They are often inaccurate, incomplete and/or show a lack of engagement. There are missing reports and attempts to delay important decisions. This means that the SoS has not been has not been provided with sufficient information on which to make a fair and balanced decision.

The extent and location of the proposed power station will have a lasting detrimental effect on pasture, on designated landscape, on listed buildings, on a World Heritage site. It will damage approximately 3,000 acres of rural Oxfordshire reaching from Tackley, Woodstock, Bladon, Long Hanborough, Church Hanborough, Cassington, Eynsham, Farmoor and Cumnor.

It will adversely affect large areas of flood plain and will require many miles of trenching, a new substation, (an additional development for which planning permission may be required.)

I await further news on the progress of this shocking development.
