We are aghast to learn that the applicant (PVDP) are intending to make some substantial new submissions on or around 16th July, Furthermore, it appears that they expect these new submissions to be included in the SOS's decision making process.

Surely, a "deadline" is a deadline. The applicant has already been provided with one extension and their further request for yet another extension declined – rightly so. They have been given every opportunity, during and post the "consultation period" to provide the detailed proposals which, as a matter of course should automatically have been submitted to the Inspectorate. Sadly, they continue to prevaricate and fail to submit the information requested. One is led to think that this may be yet another deliberate ploy on their part to challenge the SOS and their documented policies.
