Dear Secretary of State,

As an 'Interested Party', registered number 20055010, I consider that I have been let down by Photovolt Development Partners GmbH by their lack of communication regarding their plans and their change of plans for the proposed Botley West Solar Farm.

My wife and I keep hearing second hand information of proposed changes to the original plans. The maps and drawings were always difficult to understand: now we, who live in the area are being by-passed. I hope that as Secretary of State you will judge this as unjust and undemocratic.

I will say that as Interested Party we were given definite dates for when concerns could be raised. It would seem to us that PVDP have no such restrictions. This cannot be right.

In our opinion the Botley West proposal is far too large for such a high density populated area. We need our open spaces! My wife and I believe that we all need to be working for renewable energy and that this needs to be done in partnership between a developer and the community with the local authority or Secretary of State requiring 'give and take' from both partners.
