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Dear inspector

I wish to make a final comment on the applicant's failure to address the full range of questions requested by the inspectorate.

As a resident of Cassington, I am deeply concerned that the applicant has not provided proper reassurance in respect of the risk of flooding to local residents' homes and businesses.

The mitigations to the impact on visual amenity, health and wellbeing are insufficient.

Neither are the negative impacts on culture and heritage properly taken account of or addressed. The world heritage status of Blenheim needs to be taken more seriously.

The decommissioning intention, that justifies the scheme as 'temporary' is not a properly formed or funded plan.

This indicates a lack of seriousness on the part of the applicant.

If the granting of the application is dependent on answering the inspectorate's questions in a timely manner, it necessarily follows that the application cannot be approved as the questions remain unanswered by the deadline.
