
The Development comprises the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of a solar photovoltaic (PV) electricity and storage facility with an export capacity of 800 megawatts (MW), 400 battery energy storage system (BESS), and supporting infrastructure. The Development accommodates ground mounted PV generating facility together with associated works including substation, energy storage and green infrastructure.

The deadline date set for all representations to be received by the Secretary of State under section 56 was 11:59pm on 02 January 2026.

This completed certificate is to be received by the Planning Inspectorate on behalf of the Secretary of State no later than 10 working days after the deadline date stating the applicant has fulfilled all of the requirements at (a), (b) and (c) above.
